Old Schoolhouse Park Improvements

At the August 9, 2010 City Council Meeting the Council passed a resolution calling for an election to authorize the sale of bonds to complete park improvements in Old Schoolhouse Park.

To educate the public about the bond sale the City will be holding two open houses on the ballot question. The dates are Saturday, October 9, 2010 from 10:30 AM until Noon and Tuesday, October 19 from 7:00 PM to 8:30 PM.

This question will be presented to you the voters in the November 2, 2010 election. The question will read:

BONDS TO FINANCE SCHOOLHOUSE PARK IMPROVEMENTS

"Shall the City of Mayer, Minnesota, be authorized to issue its general obligation bonds in an amount not to exceed \$685,000 to finance improvements to Old Schoolhouse Park including the construction and installation of a grandstand, bleachers, lights and restrooms?"

If the question passes the average annual tax increase on a \$175,000 home would be \$78.20 a year for a term of 15 years and on a \$200,000 home would be \$89.37 a year for a term of 15 years. A Commercial Property with a tax base of \$250,000 would see an average annual increase of \$189.91 a year for a term of 15 years and a \$500,000 Commercial Property would have an annual increase of \$413.34 for a term of 15 years. . 
HELP WANTED Committee Members

Anyone missing a set of car key, other key, baseball glove, toy camera, bracelet stroller and a pair of mittens can claimed at the Mayer Community Center.



Parking During A Snow Event

The following is the City Code on parking restrictions from November until April when a one inch snow fall occurs.

71.06 PARKING DURING SNOW REMOVALS.

(A) During the months of November to April of each year commencing and ending on the first day of November and April, no motor vehicle shall be parked on either side of any street or alley within the city limits following a snowfall of one inch or more, or to otherwise interfere with snow removal operations following the accumulation of one inch of snow or more, until the completion of snow removal operations after which time parking can again be resumed upon these streets which have been cleaned of snow.

(B) No person shall park a vehicle or permit it to stand whether attended or unattended, upon any street or highway within the city within 25 feet from the intersection of the curb lines or if none, within 15 feet of the intersection of the property lines at any intersection of streets or highways.

Vehicles in violation of this ordinance will be ticketed.
