
SPRING CLEAN UP Saturday, APRIL 30

The City of Mayer has contracted with Waste Management to provide the Mayer residents with curb side clean up again this year. Have your items at the curb on Friday, April 29, 2011 they will be picked up on Saturday, April 30, 2011.

The following is a list of acceptable and unacceptable items.

Acceptable Items:

- General Non-Hazardous Household Waste "Junk"
- Furniture items (Couches, Chairs, Tables, Mattresses, Box Springs, etc.)
- Small amounts of Re-modeling materials (Siding, Dried out paint cans, Drywall, Carpet, etc.)
- All items should be boxed, bagged or contained in some manner.



Unacceptable Items:

- Appliances
- Electronics
- Asbestos
- Batteries (Includes; auto, flashlight, etc.)
- Chemical Products (Includes; herbicides, pesticides)
- Fluorescent Tubes and Light Bulbs
- Hazardous, Industrial, Infectious Waste
- Liquid Waste, Paints, Thinners, Removers
- Oils, Oil Rags (Includes; any type of oil drilling waste)
- Radioactive Materials Naturally Occurring (NORM)






GARDENERS MARKET




Mayer Trailhead Grand Opening - May 21

Carver County Parks will be holding a grand opening ceremony on Saturday, May 21, 2011 at 10:00 AM. The ceremony will take place at the trailhead in Mayer beginning with a welcome, opening remarks and an inaugural trail bike ride scheduled to begin at 11:00 AM. There will be demonstrations by the Freewheel Bike Shop and the Carver County Sheriff's Department will hold a bike rodeo.

Free Bike Helmets

As part of Minnesota's Statewide Health Improvement Program (SHIP) Grant Program, the City of Mayer has partnered with Carver-Scott SHIP. The program seeks to create sustainable, systemic changes that make it easier for Minnesotans to incorporate healthy behaviors into their daily lives. The Mayer Park Board and City Council wants to promote safe walking and biking, and encourages residents to use the newly constructed trail. As a part of the trailhead grand opening, the City will be giving away bike helmets to the first 80 kids through these grant funds.

HOW TO REDUCE JUNK MAIL

Do you receive too much junk mail? There are a few simple steps you can take to reduce the amount of junk mail you receive at home or at your office! First collect all the mail that you would not like to receive anymore (for a couple of weeks). Then contact them by phone and ask to be removed, go online to remove your name from major distributors, or send them a post-card. Changes do not often happen overnight...you should see a reduction in a few months. Re-member to recycle the unwanted mail!
