1. **PARADE STREET** – Terry Hartman has requested discussion on the possibility of developing the corner of Highway 7 and 25 with on site systems. He has changed realtor and would like to use the concept to spur development. The EDA and Planning Commission have already reviewed the issue and are in support of the concept. Si Tesch of Watertown Township was in attendance and he reported that the Township is in support of the concept. The City of Watertown has done something similar in the past. He stated that it would be beneficial for everyone to get development started at that site. The Council will get together with Hartman to discuss logistics and a time frame for eventually connecting to City utilities.
