(Dangerous Dogs)

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING BY REFERENCE CHAPTER 92 OF THE CARVER COUNTY CODE PERTAINING TO DANGEROUS AND POTENTIALLY DANGEROUS DOGS AND REPEALING SECTIONS 92.11 AND 92.12 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF MAYER PERTAINING TO DANGEROUS ANIMALS.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MAYER, CARVER COUNTY, MINNESOTA, ORDAINS:

Section 1. Code Adopted by Reference. Chapter 92 of the Carver County Code pertaining to dangerous and potentially dangerous dogs as authorized by Minnesota Statutes Section 347.51, Subd. 8, and Section 347.565, including all amendments thereto adopted and published from time to time by the Carver County Board of Commissioners, is hereby adopted by the City of Mayer and incorporated in this ordinance by reference as if fully set out herein.

Section 2. Application, Administration and Enforcement. The application, administration, and enforcement of this ordinance in the City of Mayer shall be by the "Animal Control Authority" as defined in Section 6 of Chapter 92 of the Carver County Code.

Section 3. Repealer. Section 92.11 and Section 92.12 of Chapter 92, Title IX of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Mayer are hereby repealed.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its passage according to law.
