AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF MAYER BY AMENDING SECTION 93.51, SUBD. 6, PERTAINING TO NOISE; SECTION 93.52 PERTAINING TO HOURLY RESTRICTION OF CERTAIN OPERATIONS; AND REPEALING SECTION 93.53 PERTAINING TO RECEIVING LAND USE STANDARDS.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MAYER, CARVER COUNTY, MINNESOTA, ORDAINS:

Section 1. Section 93.51, Subparagraph (G), of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Mayer pertaining to *Radios, phonographs, paging system, and the like*, is amended to delete references to phonographs and phonograph and add audio/media devices.

Section 2. Section 93.52 of the Code of ordinances of the City of Mayer pertaining to Hourly Restriction of Certain Operations is amended to read as follows:

§93.52 HOURLY RESTRICTIONS ON CERTAIN OPERATIONS.

- (A) *Recreational Vehicles.* No person shall, between the hours of 9:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m., drive or operate any minibike, or other recreational vehicle not licensed for travel on public highways. Snowmobiles may use a direct route to and from the city and are exempt from this Section.
- (B) *Domestic Power Equipment.* No person shall, between the hours of 9:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m., operate a power lawn mower, power hedge clipper, chain saw, mulcher, garden tiller, edger, drill or other similar domestic power maintenance equipment. Snow removal equipment and generators used during a power outage are exempt from this Section.
- (C) *Refuse Hauling.* No person shall, between the hours of 9:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m., collect or remove garbage or refuse in any residential district.
- (D) *Construction Activities.* No person shall, between the hours of 9:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m., engage in or permit construction activities involving the use of any kind of electric, diesel, or gas-powered machine or other power equipment.

Section 3. Section 93.53 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Mayer pertaining to **Receiving Land use Standards** is hereby **repealed**.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its passage according to law.
