

ORDINANCE NO. 183
(Lot Maintenance)
CITY OF MAYER
CARVER COUNTY, MINNESOTA
JUNE 25, 2012

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING IN ITS ENTIRETY SECTION 152.094 OF CHAPTER 152 OF TITLE XV OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF MAYER PERTAINING TO LOT MAINTENANCE.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MAYER, CARVER COUNTY, MINNESOTA, ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. § 152.094 of Chapter 152 of Title XV of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Mayer pertaining to lot maintenance is amended in its entirety to read as follows:

§ 152.094 *LOT MAINTENANCE.*

- (A) All lots with grass, hedges, landscaping, or other lawn flora (including clippings, trimmings, fallen leaves, and the like) must be maintained so as to not protrude onto public rights-of-way.
- (B) No person shall throw, put, place, push, dump, deposit or blow, or cause to be thrown, put, placed, pushed, dumped, deposited or blown, any grass, grass clippings, weeds, trees limbs, paper products, chemicals, or any other kind of rubbish or debris into or onto any public street, roadway, lane or alley.
- (C) *Penalty.* Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this section shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a petty misdemeanor and subject to the imposition of a fine of not more than \$300.00 plus the costs of prosecution.

SECTION 2. Effective date. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication according to law.
