

MAYER CITY COUNCIL WORK SESSION MEETING MINUTES ó March 15, 2011

Call Work Session meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. by Mayor Chris Capaul

The Meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance

PETITION FROM MILFRED DALCHOW

Milfred Dalchow presented information on his driveway and the opening size. David Martini addressed the driveway issue and the reasoning behind the opening size. Mr Dalchow cotends that Ridgeway Road is a City street. City records indicate that it has never been accepted by the City and is not built to City standards.

Discussion continued on various items and that Mr. Dalchow thought the City had not properly taken care of.

Mr. Dalchow requested that the City act on the petition to remove the City Administrator. Mr. Dalchow had presented additional signatures and two letters. The Mayor read the two letters into the record that Mr. Dalchow presented to the Council at last night's meeting. Letter 1 was from Arlene Steinborn and Myrtle Schuettepelz and letter 2 was from Diane Michels.

After lengthy discussion no action was taken on either letter or the petition that was presented. Council Member Boder made an official statement of support for any and all actions taken for Administrator Murphy. Council Members reiterated the statement on record stated by Council Member Boder.

MAYER LUTHERAN HIGH

Representatives from Mayer Lutheran High were present to discuss an access to Highway 25 or the reopening of 62<sup>nd</sup> Street. The City will need to decide how the access fits into the City's transportation plan. The City will need to consult with MN DOT about what access would be allowed. Staff will set up a meeting with MN DOT, City and Mayer Lutheran High to discuss the options on the access.

OTHER ISSUES

Council Member Lueth would like to discuss the City snow plowing instead of contracting out the snow plowing. Staff will place this on a future work session.
