The meeting was called to order.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The agenda was reviewed. A request was made to add the Trail Cleanup to the agenda. A motion was made by Kusske and seconded by Gomez to approve the agenda. All voted in favor. None voted against. The motion was carried.

The consent agenda was reviewed. A motion was made by Kusske and seconded by Gomez to approve the consent agenda. All voted in favor. None voted against. The motion was carried.

Consent Agenda:

1. Consider Approval of January 17<sup>th</sup>, 2023 Minutes

Nicholas Johnson updated the Board on the progress of the pavilion. The insurance company authorized the removal of the damaged roof which would be happening in the next week or so. Service Master would then be scheduled to come in and remediate the discoloration and odor of the masonry.

The Board engaged in discussion on upcoming events for 2023. Those events included:

- Twice annual Dakota Ridge Trail Cleanup – Carver County provides bags to collect trash. The consensus was to schedule the spring cleanup for May 9<sup>th</sup>, 2023 at 5:30pm out at the bridge west of the Wastewater Treatment Facility.
- Music in the Park – Held in early October with a musician playing music, Lions Club provided food, the Baseball team provided beverages, an outfit provided cookies, there were pony rides, and bounce houses.
- Christmas Tree Lighting – For 2023 the consensus was to keep it separate from the Fire Department’s Santa event. We would look into crafts to offer, Lions to provide food and beverages, and see if any of the schools would be willing to offer carolers.
