1. Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m.

2022 – Old School House Park Pavilion

2022 – Benches

2023 – Splash Pad at Old School House Park

2023 – Meadow Park & West Ridge Park trail extensions (as part of 2023 Street Project)

2024 – Dog Park – Meadow Park or West Ridge Park
2024 – Gazebos at Discovery Park and Meadow Park
2025 – Meadow Park Parking Lot
Ongoing – Old School House Park Parking Lot Expansion
Ongoing – Archery Range

C. Open Gym – Mayer Community Center

The Park Commission discussed having a Park Commission Sponsored Open Gym time for residents. There was discussion of reaching out to other local school organizations/non-profit organizations as potential partnerships in future recreational programs.

5. Staff Updates

McCallum told the Park Commission to plan for a joint Park Commission/City Council meeting on February 8, 2022 to discuss the Old School Park Pavilion.

McCallum stated that the Public Works Department has been working on getting the Old School House Park ice rink ready for use and that they are expecting it to be open starting the weekend of January 14 – 16, 2022.
