Vacancies on the Park Commission

There are two vacancies on the Park Commission. The City is required to solicit for applications for the vacancies. Notice of the vacancies have been posted on the City website and on social media.

Applications are being accepted until January 15, 2021. Interviews will be on January 20 or 21, 2021.

Recommendations will be made to Council at their January 25, 2021 meeting. Positions will start February 2021.

Ice Rink

The Public Works Department has been working for weeks to create a solid base and skating surface for the Old School House ice rink. The City advertised on social media that the rink would be open on Saturday, January 9, 2021. Staff felt that while the ice was not perfect, that most of the surface was skateable. Public Works will continue to monitor and maintain.
