Acceptable Items:

General Non-Hazardous Household Waste

Furniture items (Couches, Chairs, Tables, Mattresses, Box Springs, etc.)

Small amounts of Re-modeling material (Siding, Drywall, Carpet,
Dried out paint cans etc.)

All items should be disassembled, boxed, bagged or contained.

Unacceptable Items:

Appliances: Anything with a cord, Electronics: Includes all types of TV's, Batteries: Includes

auto, flashlight, Chemical Products: Includes herbicides, pesticides, Fluorescent Tubes and

Light Bulbs, Hazardous Materials, Asbestos, Industrial Materials, Tires, Concrete, Bricks,

Shingles, Liquid Waste, Paints, Thinners, Removers, Oils, Yard Waste: Includes grass clippings,
tree and shrub waste.

- ◆ Medicines from healthcare facilities and clinics.

- ◆ Medicines from veterinary clinics.
