



COVID-19 - Information and Resources

Dear residents and business owners,

On March 25, 2020, the Governor of Minnesota issues a stay-at-home order, intended to slow the spread of COVID-19 across the state. The order will go into effect at 11:59 p.m. on Friday, March 27, 2020 and go until Friday April 10, at 5:00 p.m.

In response to that order, the City of Mayer will be closing access to City Hall, 413 Bluejay Avenue, until the order is lifted. City staff will still be accessible by city phone and email. Appointments for essential services can also be scheduled. Essential services will continue. This includes water, sewer, fire and police services, and snowplowing.

Utility payments can still be made at City Hall in the drop box, online or by mail. . No walk-in payments will be accepted. No water will be shut off at this time

Minnesotans are still able to do things outside their home - as long as they follow social distancing recommendations.
