BUSINESS

Review Mayer Moxie

Jill Hahn was present to discuss the findings of the survey that was completed for the Mayer Moxie program. Feedback from 32 of the 54 surveys that were sent out:

- More individualized training/ goals
- Wanted it to be longer
- Liked variety of activities
- Shorter program of 8 weeks
- Nutrition information

Other comments by Jill were that 12 weeks was long because she also attended the extra Tuesday night events. She had a total of 155 hours into the program. She would propose changes to the program next year of additional trainers to assist her and add she would add a nutritionist to the program. She would be more definitive on the time and length for registrations. She would propose a higher fee for after the deadline. If she is to do this next year the day of the week would need to change from Thursday. Propose a Phase I program March – April and a Phase II program in May. Check with partnering with W/M Community Education for next year. Staff to contact the Herald Journal about doing an article on the program.

Discussion on Trees in the Park

Staff reported that there are about six dead trees in the parks. Staff will have public works remove the dead trees and replace in the fall.
