I. CALL TO ORDER

Meeting was called to order at 7:30 PM by Chair Stieve-McPadden.

BUSINESS

Sand Volleyball Courts

Park Board needed to discuss the sand volleyball courts that were scheduled to be installed in Old Schoolhouse Park. The area has a 2 ½ foot drop on the south east corner. This will require fill or changing the size of the courts. Also, the 10 foot buffer zone that needs to be created will add additional costs to the construction of the courts. Commissioner McNeilly suggested that the buffer size be adjusted to 6 feet instead of the 10 feet making the courts 84 feet by 72 feet. This will reduce the size of the courts and the cost. Council Liaison Stieve-McPadden would like to see the courts built with the 10 foot buffer. On a motion by Commissioner McNeilly and seconded by Commissioner Dodge to build the courts 100 feet by 80 feet. Motion denied 1 /2.

Park Board will discuss the sand volleyball courts at the July 14, 2015 meeting. The Park board would like to see the original bid, additional costs and trail repair costs.

Adjournment
